**FEES AND SUPPLIES FOR ELECTIVE CLASSES:**

**ELECTIVE CLASSES:**

Elective classes (not including PE) are partially funded through a fee assessed to each student taking an elective class at Hudtloff. The fee is \$12 per semester, for a maximum of \$24 per year. Please make checks payable to CPSD, with “Elective Fee” in the memo, and turn in to the Student Accounts Office next to the Main Office.

**ART** – In this class, the fee money is used to purchase supplies such as: *A Portfolio to keep work. Drawing Materials:* colored pencils, charcoal, oil pastels, markers. *Paints:* watercolor, acrylic, acrylic medium, tempera paint. *Brushes:* for watercolor and other painting. *Sculpture Supplies:* paper mache paste, wire, tape, clay and clay tools. *Glue:* white glue, glue sticks and hot glue.

- Students will need to supply the following 2 items and bring them to class every day:

**Choir uniform for performances:**
